Publicity Report

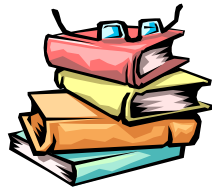

Membership Report

As of March 2007 we have 342 IARRT members (up from 324 in October 2006). There are 7 Honorary Life members, 104 Life Members, 143 PL1 members, 43 PL2 members, and 41 Supporting members. This compares to 548 members in April 2000, 523 members in April 2001, 495 members in July 2004, 365 members in August 2005, 385 members in Feb 2006 and 324 members in October 2006.

Due to the urgency of increasing membership to sustain our organization, a Membership committee was formed in September 2005. I am saddened to report the death of one of our loyal committee members. Elaine Gowell died in August 2006. Prior to her death, Elaine had sent letters regarding the benefits of joining IARRT to all the hypnotherapists listed in the Seattle area phone books as well as to two therapy groups she was a member of in the Seattle area. Though she sent out over 100 letters, it did not generate any new members. Our Membership Committee has been a geographically disbursed group with Cindy Blum in the New York area; Tricia McCannon in Georgia; Maggie Wilson in Minnesota and Michael Pollack and myself in California. During 2006 we had four conference calls and have also communicated individually by telephone and email. With Cindy's election to the Board, the death of one member and inactivity of two of the members, most of the current activities are being performed by the Bay area representatives. I have designed a preliminary IARRT recruitment brochure and have met with a graphic artist who is in the process of drawing up a draft for Board review.

We decided to take several approaches to attracting new members while also focusing upon keeping our current members:

1. We obtained the "Non Renewal" lists from Connie from 2002, 2003 and 2004, and more recently 2005 and a portion of 2006, divided them up and called each person on the list to encourage them to renew their membership, making sure we had their correct contact information (i.e. address, telephone number and email) and to elicit feedback from them about their practice, what they would like from IARRT, etc.
2. We contacted hypnotherapy schools to encourage IARRT membership among their students, inquiring if they would distribute membership applications, IARRT newsletters, flyers about IARRT sponsored training and other promotional materials.
3. Some of the Committee members wrote letters to hypnotherapists in their area describing the benefits of joining IARRT and encouraging them to join. Others approached groups with similar interests such as the A.R.E., holistic Chamber of Commerce, Noetic Science, Healing Fairs, etc. asking if they would distribute IARRT material, offering to give talks about past life therapy to their organization, while also inviting participation in our upcoming conferences. There were several write ups published about the benefits of IARRT membership along with the website address in the online e-groups such as the pastlifetherapy egroup, hypnetwork, the By Region Calendar listing; the West Coast Healers Listing; The Spiritual Healers Network, my elist of over 5,000 contacts, etc.
4. Committee Members took IARRT applications to events they were participating in such as group past life regressions, college courses, seminars or expos with metaphysical or holistic healing themes. During 2006, I have given 8 talks at Healing Fairs about Past Life Regression

as a healing modality, Research in the field of past life regression, and similar topics. Walter Semkiw and I continue to present an all day Past Life Workshop at Solano College and we always talk about IARRT, take application forms with us and encourage attendees to join IARRT. I do several group past life regressions each year to introduce the theme of past life regression to the public. This has resulted in a number of positive newspaper articles including a 2 page spread in the SF Chronicle. I have taped 4 Television programs on Past Life Regression in 2006 including one where a client (who suffered severe phobias had remission of symptoms following past life regression) was interviewed. These were broadcast in the SF Bay area and I have videotapes of the broadcasts.

5. We contacted over 500 "expired membership" individuals and found the following:
 - a. Several of the older (i.e. 2002 vintage) "non renewals" could not be reached as the telephone number had been disconnected and there was no new listing found.
 - b. Approximately 28 people indicated they would send their renewal applications and dues in. Some did this following a discussion about the benefits of IARRT membership, a discussion about the upcoming conference, or our pointing out the advantages of a prestige page on the IARRT website with world wide referrals from the website.
 - c. Some indicated they did not receive a renewal form in the mail (we verified addresses when this occurred).
 - d. Some said they were not practicing past life therapy anymore, while others said their geographical area was too conservative to be receptive to Past Life Therapy. (We discussed techniques such as past life workshops, talks at metaphysical groups/churches, etc.) to reach individuals interested in Past Life work.
 - e. The restrictive changes in some state laws (such as NY), which make referring to yourself as a hypnotherapist a felony unless you are a M.D., PhD psychologist or Social Worker had discouraged some from continuing their practice.
 - f. Some individuals were experiencing economic restrictions and reported having to "cut all nonessentials".
 - g. Some individuals were disgruntled with their perceptions of the "direction" of IARRT saying they felt we had drifted from our focus on past life therapy to more "woo woo " topics, others expressed frustration with loss of services such as a printed Journal, research articles, a printed newsletter, etc.
6. I have maintained ongoing correspondence with many people from the World Congress and from contacts with other hypnotherapy focused organizations. Through ongoing dialogue, including keeping individuals abreast of Conference themes, research being explored, and various advantages of belonging to IARRT has resulted in individuals completing IARRT membership applications. It seems like one on one discussion between a current member and a potential member is the most effective tool in getting new people to complete a membership application.

Goals for the coming Year:

1. Continue to recruit new members at hypnotherapy schools and organizations with similar interests and in e-groups.
2. Do talks at events (Whole life Expo's, Healing fairs, churches, etc.) about Past Life Therapy and IARRT taking membership applications and promotional material with us.
3. Devise an incentive program for members who recruit members.

4. Continue to work with individuals on the Membership Committee to strengthen and reinforce their commitment to our goals, to brainstorm for new approaches to increase membership and to establish a "presence" geographically for IARRT.
5. Contact 2006 and 2007 non-renewing members to encourage continuation of IARRT membership, eliciting feedback and suggestions while also speaking of the many benefits of membership.
6. Continue outreach to members in the newsletter, soliciting comments on what we can do to improve the organization.
7. Work on a marketing plan with the Director of Marketing to enhance IARRT's image and attract new members. Our annual conference can be a major source of new potential members so I hope to work closely with the Marketing Director to get the word out about our upcoming East Coast conference.
8. Work cooperatively with the person responsible for web maintenance to make the site more user friendly. This would also entail updating articles on the website, having "keywords" appropriate for attracting a higher result from the major search engines, while encouraging members and related organizations to link to our site.
9. Work on placing articles, TV programs, radio shows which not only generate public interest, but also mention IARRT as a major source of information and referral on past life therapies.

I have taped a series of four TV programs for a local cable TV station. The first program was on Reincarnation, the second on past life regression as a healing modality; the third discussed "In Between Life" Regression and the Fourth was an interview with one of my clients that had severe phobias who was helped significantly (both his phobia as well as lifelong physical problems...asthma and severe allergies) through regression therapy. The IARRT website and contact information is shown several times during each program and has resulted in several phone calls/emails. Once a program has been produced, the tape can be loaned to other TV stations for their cable access programming. We can look into the possibility of obtaining videos, which might be shared with others seeking to do research or for public education purposes.

I would appreciate hearing any suggestions from you about increasing IARRT membership. Are each of you taking membership forms with you when you give a talk or workshop related to past life therapy?

Enhanced membership would provide the funds to publish a print Journal, would allow more conferences, printed newsletters and greater visibility for our organization hence enhanced client referrals to members. New IARRT Past Life Research Survey!

Please give the survey to your clients.

The time has arrived for all IARRT members who use past life regression with clients to become fellow researchers and join together in playing a key role in sharing with the world the benefits of this modality. Art Roffey received his doctorate in Counseling Psychology from the University of Southern California and is licensed as a Psychologist in the State of Michigan.
